## A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENT

Early in the spring of 2020, we were led through much prayer and consideration to focus our search for **Hero's Rest land in the Missouri Ozarks**. In March we found 15 beautiful acres and a generous couple willing to accept an extended closing so that we could fundraise to purchase the land! The Lord's timing is perfect, He knew the difficult things that were soon to come. He knew that the need for Hero's Rest was about to increase exponentially.

While signing the contract on the **15 acres**, I had asked the realtor about 40 acres bordering the land but he said it was unlikely to become available since it was sold the year prior. I prayed that day if the Lord wanted us there, that he would not only bring us the pledges to acquire the 15, but that he would also put the 40 on the market and bring us the pledges for that as well. **Three weeks later**, I got a call from the realtor that the 40 had just gone on the market! In just a matter of months we were able to close on both properties because of the generosity of our donors. In September, we picked up one more acre between our property and the road.

We began 2020 praying to find 10-20 acres and **ended the year with 56 acres** and staff accommodations underway! Thank you to all who donated, pledged to donate, and prayed. You have made this all possible. Despite the challenges of this year, you gave generously to support the brave men and women of this nation. You have helped us take this huge step to giving them rest in nature with the Lord.

As you read through this annual report, **praise the Lord for all he has done this year**, both for Hero's Rest and in the Trauma Support Program. I pray the He would sustain and lead you in the year to come.



Your generosity has made it possible to begin building phase 1 of Hero's Rest on 56 acres of land in the Missouri Ozarks. In 2021 we will move our base of operations for Shalam Ministries to the Hero's Rest property. This will allow our staff to develop phase 1 of Hero's Rest, host our first hero guests, and continue providing trauma support via phone and video conferencing.


